BEGINNING KNITTING

Price: \$30

Get started! Learn all the basics: how to cast on, knit, purl and bind off.

Materials needed:
knitting needles size 8 or 9

Practice yarn provided.

2 SESSIONS IN THIS CLASS:

Wednesdays: March 10 and 17, from 1 to 3 pm



THE TOMTEN JACKET

Price: \$55

Knit this interesting (but not too challenging) Elizabeth Zimmermann sweater-jacket to learn a few different construction techniques. We will be knitting the child's size, so that the jacket can be finished by the end of class.

Materials needed: Knitting needles, yarn*, scissors, darning needle

*yarn for project depends upon the size of the garment. Contact instructor for yarn choices.

SOCK KNITTING 101

Price: \$45

Pattern provided

Prerequisite: Beginning Knitting or equivalent. Helpful to know decrease stitches. Learn to knit a pair of socks - heel turning, knitting on double pointed needles, toe darning. Socks are a compact project and easy to carry with you.

Materials needed: One set of double pointed needles, worsted sock yarn, darning needle, and scissors

Price: \$35

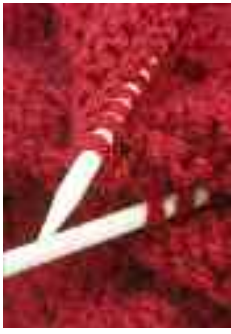

CONTINUING KNITTING

Price: \$35

Learn to be a better knitter. We will do increasing, decreasing, simple decorative stitches and introduce principles of pattern reading and garment making. Emphasis will be placed on the importance

of making an accurate gauge swatch.

Prerequisite: Beginning Knitting or equivalent. Must know how to knit, purl, cast on and bind off.

WEAVING ON THE RIGID HEDDLE LOOM

This loom from Ashford Wheels & Looms of New Zealand, is for the beginning or intermediate weaver who would like a portable loom. In this class, students will warp their loom and learn to weave and finish a simple woven scarf.

BEGINNING WHEEL SPINNING

Limited to 4 students

Price: \$45 plus cost of fiber

Learn to spin with a spinning wheel and how to prepare your yarn for either weaving, knitting or crochet projects. Spinning is a very relaxing pastime that can be done year 'round. if you've ever wanted to own a spinning wheel, this class will teach you basic spinning, as well as how to maintain your wheel.

3 SESSIONS IN THIS CLASS:

Saturdays: May 1, 8, and 15, from 10 am to 12 noon



A SIMPLE LACY SHAWL

Price: \$35

This is an introduction to knitting lace, we will learn some basic lace stitches, how to read charted designs and make a small lace scarf or shawl.

Prerequisite: Continuing Knitting or equivalent. Must know how to knit, purl, cast on, bind off, increase and decrease.

Materials needed: Needles (size dependent on yarn used), yarn for lace project (suitable yarns to be discussed at first class - bring any soft, fine yarns to consider) Darning needle, scissors, stitch holders, stitch markers, post it pad and pencil.

2 SESSIONS IN THIS CLASS:

Wednesdays: May 5 and 12, from 1 to 3 pm

THE WEEKEND SWEATER CLASS

Price: \$60

Spend the third weekend in April knitting a top down sweater from one of Diane Soucy's "Knitting Pure & Simple" patterns. We will begin on Friday afternoon, meet again on Saturday afternoon and our final class will be Sunday morning, for a total of nine hours concentrating on learning and having fun with these simple garments. In order to complete your project during this 3-day class, a vest, child's size or baby's sweater is recommended.

4 SESSIONS IN THIS CLASS: Friday, April 23, Saturday, April 24, from 1 to 4 pm; and Sunday, April 25, from 9 am to 12 noon.
